OFFICIAL RULES OF THE PRIZE GAME AND PRIVACY NOTICE

I. OFFICIAL RULES

1. Organizer of the Prize Game

1.1. The organizer of the promotional prize game entitled “**PBT World Fencing Championships Prediction Game 2026**” is:

(hereinafter referred to as the “**Organizer**”).

1.2. The Organizer is responsible for the administration of the Game, including the processing of Entries, the evaluation of Predictions, the conduct of the Prize Draw, the notification of Winners, and the delivery of the Prizes.

1.3. The technical service provider of the online Entry Form is **Tally BV**, registered at August Van Lokerenstraat 71, 9050 Ghent, Belgium (hereinafter referred to as “**Tally**”).

2. Name and Purpose of the Game

2.1. The Organizer organizes a promotional prediction game entitled “**PBT World Fencing Championships Prediction Game 2026**”, participation in which is **not conditional upon the purchase of any product or service** (hereinafter referred to as the “**Game**”).

The purpose of the Game is for Participants to predict the winners of the following six individual events of the **2026 World Fencing Championships**:

- a) Women’s Foil Individual Event;
- b) Men’s Foil Individual Event;
- c) Women’s Épée Individual Event;
- d) Men’s Épée Individual Event;
- e) Women’s Sabre Individual Event;
- f) Men’s Sabre Individual Event.

IMPORTANT: The list of athletes available on the website has been compiled based on the entries published on the official FIE entry website as of **13 July 2026**. The Organizer is unable to update the list to reflect any entries submitted after that date or the subsequent withdrawal of any athlete.

2.2. The Game is promoted by the Organizer through a post published on its Instagram page at https://www.instagram.com/pbt_fencing/.

However, participation in the Game does **not** take place via Instagram. Entries may only be submitted by completing and submitting the online Entry Form available on the Organizer's website at www.pbtfencing.com.

3. Duration of the Game

3.1. The Game will run during the following period:

Start: 13 July 2026, 10:00 (CEST)

End: 21 July 2026, 18:00 (CEST)

3.2. All dates and times referred to in these Official Rules shall mean the local time applicable in Budapest, Hungary, namely **Central European Summer Time (CEST, UTC+2)** during the Game Period.

3.3. The time of Entry shall be the time at which the fully completed online Entry Form is successfully recorded in the Tally system.

3.4. Any Entry received before the opening of the Game or after the closing time of the Game shall be invalid.

4. Eligibility

4.1. The Game is open to any natural person who:

- a) has reached the age of **18 years** at the time of submitting the Entry;
- b) has legal capacity to act;
- c) submits a valid Entry in accordance with these Official Rules; and
- d) does not fall within any of the categories of excluded persons specified in this Section (hereinafter referred to as the **"Participant"**).

4.2. Individuals residing in any country are eligible to participate in the Game.

4.3. The following persons are not eligible to participate in the Game:

- a) the executive officers, employees of the Organizer, and any persons directly involved in the organization or administration of the Game;
- b) close relatives, as defined by the Hungarian Civil Code, of the persons referred to in point (a);
- c) any person who unlawfully influences or attempts to influence the administration, fairness, or outcome of the Game.

4.4. By submitting the Entry Form, the Participant declares that they are at least **18 years of age** and are eligible to participate in the Game.

5. Free Participation

5.1. Participation in the Game is free of charge and is **not** conditional upon the purchase of any product or service, the payment of any fee, or the provision of any other consideration of monetary value.

5.2. The Participant shall bear any ordinary costs associated with accessing the Entry Form and using an internet connection.

6. How to Enter

6.1. To participate in the Game, the Participant must follow the Organizer's Instagram account at https://www.instagram.com/pbt_fencing/ and complete and submit the online Entry Form available at <https://shop.pbtfencing.com/socialcontest>.

6.2. When submitting an Entry, the Participant must provide the following information:

- a) full name;
- b) e-mail address;
- c) country of residence;
- d) one prediction for the winner of each of the six individual events specified in Section 2.1;
- e) confirmation that they are at least 18 years of age; and
- f) confirmation that they have read and accepted these Official Rules and have read the Privacy Notice.

6.3. The Participant may voluntarily consent, by selecting a separate **unchecked** checkbox, to receive direct marketing, promotional and commercial communications from the Organizer by electronic means. Refusal to provide such consent shall not affect the validity of the Entry.

6.4. A valid Entry may only be submitted if the Participant selects **one predicted winner for each of the six individual events**. Entries containing incomplete predictions cannot be submitted and, if submitted, shall be deemed invalid.

6.5. The Participant must provide accurate, complete and truthful personal information relating to themselves. The unauthorized use of another person's name or e-mail address is prohibited.

6.6. Once submitted, an Entry, including the Participant's Predictions, may not be amended or withdrawn, without prejudice to the exercise of the Participant's rights under applicable data protection legislation.

7. Multiple Entries

7.1. Each Participant may participate in the Game with **one valid Entry only**.

7.2. If multiple Entries are submitted using the same full name and e-mail address, only the **first valid Entry received** shall be taken into account. Any subsequent Entries shall neither modify nor replace the first Entry.

7.3. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any Participant who attempts to submit multiple Entries by using multiple e-mail addresses or another person's personal data, or who otherwise attempts to unfairly increase their chances of winning.

8. Evaluation of Predictions

8.1. Predictions shall be evaluated on the basis of the official final results published on the official website of the **2026 World Fencing Championships Hong Kong China** at <https://www.fencing2026.com>. In the event of any discrepancy between the results published on that website and the final official results published by the **International Fencing Federation (FIE)** at <https://fie.org/competitions>, the final results published by the FIE shall prevail.

8.2. A Participant shall become eligible for a Prize Draw in respect of a particular weapon category if they correctly predict the winner of either the men's or the women's individual event in that weapon category.

8.3. If a Participant correctly predicts both the men's and the women's winners in the same weapon category, this shall **not** result in two entries into the corresponding Prize Draw. The Participant shall receive **one entry only** into the Prize Draw for that weapon category.

8.4. Correct Predictions made in another weapon category shall not increase the Participant's chances of winning in the Prize Draw relating to a different weapon category.

8.5. Accordingly:

a) the **Foil Prize Draw** shall include all Participants who correctly predicted the winner of either the Women's Foil Individual Event or the Men's Foil Individual Event;

b) the **Épée Prize Draw** shall include all Participants who correctly predicted the winner of either the Women's Épée Individual Event or the Men's Épée Individual Event;

c) the **Sabre Prize Draw** shall include all Participants who correctly predicted the winner of either the Women's Sabre Individual Event or the Men's Sabre Individual Event.

8.6. Example: If a Participant correctly predicts both the Women's Foil Individual Event winner and the Men's Foil Individual Event winner, as well as the Women's Sabre Individual Event winner, they will receive **one entry** into the Foil Prize Draw and **one entry** into the Sabre Prize Draw.

8.7. The official results available at the time of the Prize Draw shall serve as the basis for the Draw. Any subsequent disqualification, anti-doping decision, amendment of the official results, or any other change occurring after the Prize Draw has been completed shall not affect the outcome of the Prize Draw or the Winner's entitlement to the Prize.

8.8. If any individual event has not been completed, has been cancelled, or has been postponed in such a way that its official result is not available by the scheduled date of the Prize Draw, the Organizer shall postpone the Prize Draw relating to the affected weapon category.

9. Prize Draw Categories and Limitation of One Prize per Participant

9.1. The Organizer shall conduct **three separate Prize Draws**:

- a) **Foil Prize Draw;**
- b) **Épée Prize Draw;**
- c) **Sabre Prize Draw.**

9.2. Each Participant may win a **maximum of one Prize** in the Game.

9.3. A Participant who qualifies for more than one Prize Draw shall be included in each relevant Prize Draw. If the Participant is selected as a Winner in any Prize Draw, they shall be removed from all subsequent Prize Draws.

9.4. The Prize Draws shall be conducted in the following order:

- a) Foil;
- b) Épée;
- c) Sabre.

10. Conduct of the Prize Draw

10.1. The Organizer shall conduct the three Prize Draws within **five (5) calendar days** following the publication of the official final results of all relevant individual events.

10.2. The Prize Draws shall take place at the Organizer's registered office (Tevet utca 9., Building D, Ground Floor, Door 6, H-1139 Budapest, Hungary) and through the electronic system used by the Organizer.

10.3. The Prize Draws shall be conducted electronically using the built-in random number generation function of **Microsoft Excel**.

10.4. Prior to each Prize Draw, the Organizer shall:

- a) finalize the database of all valid Entries;
- b) identify the Participants eligible for the relevant weapon category Prize Draw;
- c) remove all invalid and duplicate Entries; and
- d) include each eligible Participant **once only** in the relevant Prize Draw.

10.5. In the event of a technical error, data loss, a corrupted database, or the incorrect application of the Prize Draw criteria, the Prize Draw may be repeated using the same group of eligible Participants and under the same conditions.

10.6. A repeated Prize Draw may only be conducted where the error materially affected or may have materially affected the outcome of the original Prize Draw.

11. Prizes

11.1. A total of **three (3)** individually designed and assembled **PBT fencing piste models**, made from **LEGO® elements** and including minifigures, will be awarded as Prizes in the Game (individually referred to as a “**Prize**” and collectively as the “**Prizes**”).

11.2. The approximate retail value of each Prize is **HUF 35,000 / EUR 100**.

11.3. The Prizes are custom-made promotional PBT models assembled using LEGO® elements. They are **not** official LEGO® sets manufactured, marketed, licensed, or approved by the LEGO Group.

11.4. LEGO® is a trademark of the LEGO Group. The LEGO Group does not sponsor, authorize, endorse, or approve the Prizes. Furthermore, the LEGO Group does not authorize any modification of LEGO® elements in any manner or form and accepts no liability for any unforeseen and/or adverse consequences arising from such modifications.

11.5. The right to receive a Prize is personal to the Winner and may not be transferred to another person, exchanged for cash or any other product, or offered for sale.

12. Notification of the Winner and Publication of the Results

12.1. The Organizer shall notify the Winner by e-mail, using the e-mail address provided in the Entry, within **five (5) calendar days** following the Prize Draw.

12.2. The Organizer shall publish the results of the Game on **<https://shop.pbt fencing.com/socialcontest>**.

12.3. The published results shall include only the Winner’s:

- a) first name and surname; and
- b) country provided at the time of Entry.

12.4. The Organizer shall not publish the Winner’s e-mail address, postal address, or any other direct contact details.

12.5. The Winner’s first name, surname, and country shall remain publicly available for a maximum of **thirty (30) days** from the publication of the results.

12.6. By submitting an Entry, the Participant acknowledges that, if selected as a Winner, the information specified in Section **12.3** may be published by the Organizer for the purpose of announcing the results of the Prize Draw and ensuring the transparency of the Game.

12.7. The Organizer shall not publish the names, countries, or any other personal data of the other Participants in connection with the Prize Draw.

13. Winner Confirmation and Prize Delivery

13.1. Within **fourteen (14) calendar days** of the date on which the Winner Notification is sent, the Winner shall reply to the notification e-mail and provide:

- a) full name;
- b) delivery address;

- c) country;
- d) telephone number, where required by the courier service for delivery; and
- e) any other information required for customs clearance or international delivery.

13.2. Where the Organizer has reasonable grounds for doubt, it shall be entitled to request appropriate proof of the Winner's age, identity, and eligibility to participate in the Game. Personal data not required for the verification of eligibility may be redacted from the supporting documents.

13.3. If the Winner:

- a) fails to respond within the fourteen (14)-day period;
- b) fails to prove their eligibility to participate despite the Organizer's reasonable request;
- c) fails to provide the information required for delivery;
- d) does not meet the participation requirements set out in these Official Rules;
- e) declines the Prize; or
- f) has provided false information,

the Winner shall forfeit their entitlement to the Prize.

13.4. In the cases specified in Sections **13.3** and **13.4**, the Organizer shall conduct a new Prize Draw among the Participants eligible for the relevant weapon category.

13.5. The Organizer shall conduct no more than **two (2)** redraws in respect of any Prize.

13.6. The Organizer shall dispatch the Prize by post or courier within **thirty (30) calendar days** after receiving all information required for delivery.

13.7. The Organizer shall bear the ordinary costs of delivering the Prize to the Winner and, to the extent permitted by the applicable laws and the selected method of delivery, any customs duties, import VAT or other import taxes, customs clearance fees, customs brokerage fees, and mandatory administrative charges directly related to the importation of the Prize.

13.8. The Winner shall bear any income tax, prize tax, gift tax, or any other direct tax personally payable under the laws applicable to their place of residence, habitual residence, or tax residence in connection with the acquisition of the Prize, as well as any costs associated with fulfilling the related tax filing and tax administration obligations.

13.9. The Winner shall bear any costs of repeated delivery, storage, return shipment, and re-dispatch arising from incorrect information provided by the Winner, failure to cooperate, unjustified refusal to accept the shipment, or unsuccessful delivery attributable to the Winner.

14. Voluntary User-Generated Content (UGC)

14.1. Following receipt of the Prize, the Organizer may contact the Winner on a voluntary basis for the purpose of inviting the Winner to create a photograph, short video, or social media post featuring the Prize.

14.2. The Winner may decline such invitation without providing any reason. Such refusal shall not affect the Winner's status as the Winner or the delivery of the Prize.

14.3. Any republication, use for advertising purposes, modification, use in paid advertisements, or use of the Winner's name, image, or voice in connection with content created by the Winner shall be subject exclusively to a separate agreement concluded with the Winner.

15. Invalid Entries and Disqualification

15.1. Without limitation, an Entry shall be deemed invalid if it:

- a) is submitted outside the Entry Period;
- b) does not contain all mandatory information and all six Predictions;
- c) contains false, misleading, or another person's personal data;
- d) is submitted by a person under the age of 18;
- e) has been submitted using an automated system, robot, software, or any other unfair technical means;
- f) is intended to circumvent these Official Rules or to unfairly increase the Participant's chances of winning; or
- g) violates applicable law, public morals, or the rights of any third party.

15.2. The Organizer shall be entitled to disqualify any Participant who:

- a) commits or attempts to commit fraud, abuse, or manipulation;
- b) unlawfully interferes with the operation of the Organizer's IT systems;
- c) submits multiple Entries or Entries using a false identity;
- d) engages in unlawful conduct towards the Organizer; or
- e) materially breaches any provision of these Official Rules.

15.3. Where reasonably practicable, the Organizer shall notify the affected Participant of the disqualification by e-mail using the e-mail address provided in the Entry.

15.4. The Organizer shall not exercise its right to disqualify Participants arbitrarily, in a discriminatory manner, or for the purpose of subsequently influencing the outcome of the Game.

16. Technical Requirements and Liability

16.1. It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure that they have an appropriate internet connection, a suitable device, and a functioning e-mail address for completing the Entry Form.

16.2. The Organizer shall not be liable for any of the following circumstances beyond its reasonable control:

- a) internet or network failures;
- b) e-mail delivery failures or the operation of spam filters;
- c) failures of the Participant's device or software;
- d) incorrect information provided by the Participant; or
- e) temporary interruptions in services provided by third parties.

16.3. The Organizer shall not be liable for any notification or delivery difficulties arising from an incorrect e-mail address, name, country, or delivery address provided by the Participant.

16.4. Nothing in these Official Rules shall exclude or limit the Organizer's liability for damage caused intentionally or in any case where the exclusion or limitation of liability is prohibited by mandatory applicable law.

16.5. The Organizer shall not be liable for any damage resulting from the improper use of the Prize.

17. Amendment, Suspension and Termination of the Game

17.1. Following the commencement of the Game, the Organizer shall not amend the conditions of the Game to the detriment of the Participants, except where such amendment is strictly necessary due to:

- a) a change in applicable law;
- b) a decision of a competent authority or court;
- c) a technical error;
- d) force majeure;
- e) the cancellation, interruption, or material modification of the competition; or
- f) any other unavoidable circumstance beyond the Organizer's reasonable control.

17.2. The Organizer shall publish clear and timely notice of any necessary amendment, suspension, or termination on the website where these Official Rules are available.

18. Instagram Disclaimer

18.1. This Game is in no way sponsored, administered, endorsed, or associated with Instagram or its operator.

18.2. The Participant acknowledges that their personal data are provided to the Organizer and **not** to Instagram.

18.3. The Participant shall comply with Instagram's applicable Terms of Use and Community Guidelines at all times. The use of false, misleading, or unauthorized Instagram tags or references is prohibited.

19. Complaints

19.1. Any questions, comments, or complaints relating to the Game may be submitted by e-mail to **sales@pbt fencing.com**.

19.2. A complaint shall include the Participant's name, e-mail address, the subject of the complaint, and the material facts necessary for its assessment.

19.3. The Organizer shall investigate the complaint as soon as reasonably practicable, but no later than **thirty (30) days** after its receipt, and shall notify the Participant of its response by e-mail.

20. Governing Law, Language and Final Provisions

20.1. The Game and these Official Rules shall be governed by the laws of Hungary.

20.2. The application of Hungarian law shall not deprive any Participant qualifying as a consumer of the protection afforded by the mandatory provisions of the law of their country of habitual residence from which no derogation may be made by agreement.

20.3. Any dispute arising in connection with the Game shall fall within the jurisdiction of the court having competence and jurisdiction in accordance with the applicable Hungarian and European Union rules on jurisdiction.

20.4. These Official Rules have been drafted in the Hungarian language. The Organizer may also make an English-language translation available.

20.5. In the event of any discrepancy between the Hungarian-language and the English-language versions, the **Hungarian / English** version shall prevail, provided that the Participant may rely on the language version that was reasonably available to them.

20.6. These Official Rules shall be available free of charge throughout the entire duration of the Game at **<https://shop.pbt fencing.com/socialcontest>**, where they may be downloaded or permanently saved.

20.7. Before submitting the Entry Form, the Participant shall be given the opportunity to access and read these Official Rules and the Privacy Notice via the relevant links.

20.8. Any matters not regulated by these Official Rules shall be governed by the applicable laws of Hungary and, where applicable, the laws of the European Union.

2. Scope of this Privacy Notice

2.1. This Privacy Notice applies to the processing of personal data carried out in connection with the prize game entitled “**PBT World Fencing Championships Prediction Game 2026**”.

2.2. The Organizer processes the personal data of Participants in particular in accordance with **Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR)**, **Act CXII of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information**, and **Act XLVIII of 2008 on the Basic Requirements and Certain Restrictions of Commercial Advertising Activities**.

2.3. Capitalized terms used in this Privacy Notice and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings assigned to them in the **Official Rules**.

3.1. Processing of Personal Data for Participation in the Game

Purpose and Data Subjects	Receipt and registration of Entries, verification of eligibility requirements, recording and evaluation of Predictions, determination of Participants eligible for the Prize Draw, and conduct of the Prize Draw. Data subjects: individuals submitting an Entry to the Game.
Categories of Personal Data Processed	Full name, e-mail address, country, Predictions submitted for the six individual events, confirmation that the Participant is at least 18 years of age, confirmation of acceptance of the Official Rules and acknowledgement of the Privacy Notice, date and time of the Entry, and data relating to the validity of the Entry, correct Predictions, and eligibility for the Prize Draw.
Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(b) GDPR: performance of the contractual relationship established under the Official Rules, and taking steps at the request of the Participant prior to participation in the Game.
Retention Period	One (1) year following the conclusion of the Game. In the event of a complaint, legal dispute, or administrative proceeding, the data may be retained until the final resolution of the matter and the expiry of any related legal claims.

Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Authorized employees of the Data Controller involved in the administration of the Game; Tally BV (registered office: August Van Lokerenstraat 71, 9050 Ghent, Belgium), acting as the data processor providing the online Entry Form.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	Providing the mandatory personal data is a condition of participation in the Game. Without such data, a valid Entry cannot be submitted.
Transfers to Third Countries	Tally BV stores the personal data submitted via the online Entry Form on servers located within the European Union. Tally BV engages sub-processors for the provision of its services. Should personal data be transferred to a third country outside the European Economic Area through the involvement of any sub-processor, such transfer shall take place only in accordance with the conditions and appropriate safeguards set out in Chapter V of the GDPR .

3.2. Prevention of Abuse and Enforcement of the Official Rules

Purpose and Data Subjects	Detection of multiple, automated, false, or otherwise fraudulent Entries, enforcement of the Official Rules, and ensuring the fair conduct of the Game. Data subjects: individuals submitting an Entry to the Game.
Categories of Personal Data Processed	Full name, e-mail address, date and time of the Entry, submitted Entries and Predictions, and data relating to similarities or differences between Entries.
Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(f) GDPR: the legitimate interest of the Data Controller in ensuring the fair, lawful, and verifiable conduct of the Game, preventing abuse, and protecting its legal claims.
Retention Period	One (1) year following the conclusion of the Game. In the event of a complaint or legal dispute, the data may be retained until the final resolution of the matter and the expiry of any related legal claims.
Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Authorized employees of the Data Controller involved in the administration of the Game; where necessary, legal representatives, competent authorities, or courts.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	The processing is based on the data provided during the Entry process and the data generated by the Entry system. No additional personal data are required from the Participant.

3.3. Processing of Personal Data for Winner Notification, Eligibility Verification and Prize Delivery

Purpose and Data Subjects	Notification of the Winner, verification of the Winner's eligibility to participate, collection of delivery details, delivery of the Prize by post or courier, sending a one-time invitation to voluntarily create social media content relating to the Prize, and handling the Winner's response. Data subjects: Winners selected in the Prize Draw and, where applicable, Winners selected in any redraw.
Categories of Personal Data Processed	Full name, e-mail address, country, delivery address, telephone number, data required for delivery and, where applicable, for customs clearance in the case of international delivery, as well as data relating to the Winner Notification and the delivery of the Prize.
Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(b) GDPR: performance of the contractual relationship established under the Official Rules. Where the processing is necessary for compliance with the Data Controller's obligations under tax, accounting, or customs legislation, the legal basis shall be Article 6(1)(c) GDPR .
Retention Period	Data required for delivery may be processed for up to one (1) year following the conclusion of the Game after the delivery of the Prize has been completed. Data forming part of accounting, tax, or customs records shall be retained for the period required by the applicable legislation.
Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Authorized employees of the Data Controller; the selected postal or courier service provider; and, where necessary, customs brokers, customs authorities, accountants, or tax advisors.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	Providing the Winner's details and delivery information is a condition for the delivery of the Prize. Without such information, the Prize cannot be delivered, and the Winner may forfeit their entitlement to the Prize in accordance with the Official Rules.
Transfers to Third Countries	If the Winner provides a delivery address in a country outside the European Economic Area, the personal data required for delivery may be transferred to the postal service, courier service, or customs authority operating in the destination country.

3.4. Publication of the Winner's Personal Data

Purpose and Data Subjects	Announcement of the results of the Game and ensuring the transparency and credibility of the Prize Draw. Data subjects: Winners of the Game.
Categories of Personal Data Processed	The Winner's first name and the country provided at the time of Entry.

Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(f) GDPR: the legitimate interest of the Data Controller in ensuring the transparent and credible publication of the results of the Game and demonstrating that the Prize has been awarded.
Retention Period	Up to thirty (30) days following publication of the results.
Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Visitors to the Organizer's website publishing the results of the Game.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	The Data Controller uses the published data from the information provided during the Entry process. The Winner may object to the processing on grounds relating to their particular situation.

3.5. Processing of Personal Data for Marketing Communications

Purpose and Data Subjects	Sending marketing and promotional e-mails relating to PBT products, services, promotions, events, and other offers. Data subjects: Participants who have given their separate consent.
Categories of Personal Data Processed	E-mail address; name, where used for personalizing communications; the date, source, and version of the consent given; IP address; and the fact and date of withdrawal of consent.
Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(a) GDPR: the data subject's freely given consent; and the prior, specific, and explicit consent required under Section 6(1) of Act XLVIII of 2008 on the Basic Requirements and Certain Restrictions of Commercial Advertising Activities . The legal basis for retaining the limited data necessary to demonstrate the granting and withdrawal of consent is Article 6(1)(f) GDPR , namely the Data Controller's legitimate interest in demonstrating lawful processing.
Retention Period	Until consent is withdrawn. Following withdrawal, the processing of personal data for marketing purposes shall cease. The limited data required to demonstrate consent may be retained until the expiry of the applicable limitation period for related legal claims.
Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Employees of the Data Controller responsible for marketing activities.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	Voluntary. 3.6. Processing of Enquiries Relating to the Game

Categories of Personal Data Processed	Name, e-mail address, the content of the enquiry, the date of the communication, and any other information necessary for responding to the enquiry.
Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(b) GDPR where the enquiry relates to participation in the Game or the delivery of the Prize; otherwise, Article 6(1)(f) GDPR , based on the Data Controller's legitimate interest in responding to enquiries.
Retention Period	Until the enquiry has been resolved. Thereafter, only the data necessary in connection with a contract or legal claim may continue to be processed until the expiry of the applicable limitation period.
Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Employees of the Data Controller responsible for handling enquiries; the e-mail service provider; and, where necessary, legal representatives or other service providers involved in handling the enquiry.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	Contacting the Organizer is voluntary. However, without the contact details necessary for responding, the Data Controller will be unable to reply to the enquiry.

3.7. Processing of Complaints and Data Subject Requests

Purpose and Data Subjects	Investigation, handling, and documentation of complaints relating to the Game, data protection requests, and legal claims. Data subjects: individuals submitting complaints, requests, or legal claims.
Categories of Personal Data Processed	Name, e-mail address, postal address, the content of the complaint or request, data relating to participation in the Game, attached documents, the Data Controller's response, and data relating to the handling of the case.
Legal Basis	Article 6(1)(c) GDPR where processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation; Article 6(1)(f) GDPR where processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims.
Retention Period	Three (3) years in the case of consumer complaints. In all other cases, until the final conclusion of the legal dispute or administrative proceeding and the expiry of any related legal claims.

Recipients or Categories of Recipients	Employees of the Data Controller responsible for handling the matter; legal representatives; and, where necessary, competent authorities, courts, or other dispute resolution bodies.
Whether the Provision of Data is Mandatory	Submission of a complaint or request is voluntary. However, without the information necessary to assess the complaint or request, the matter cannot be investigated, or can only be investigated to a limited extent.

4. Data Security

4.1. The Data Controller implements technical and organizational measures appropriate to the risks associated with the processing of personal data in order to ensure the security of such data.

5. Automated Decision-Making and Profiling

5.1. The Data Controller does not carry out automated decision-making or profiling based on automated processing of personal data.

5.2. The Winner is selected randomly using a computer-generated random number function. However, the group of Participants eligible for the Prize Draw and the outcome of the Prize Draw are verified by the Organizer.

6. Rights of Data Subjects

6.1. Under the GDPR, data subjects may exercise the following rights. Requests relating to the exercise of these rights may be submitted by e-mail to sales@pbtffencing.com.

- **Right to information and access:** The data subject may request confirmation as to whether PBT processes their personal data and, if so, request access to such personal data and the related information.
- **Right to rectification:** The data subject may request the correction of inaccurate personal data or the completion of incomplete personal data.
- **Right to erasure:** The data subject may request the deletion of their personal data where the purpose of the processing no longer exists, the processing is unlawful, consent has been withdrawn, or any other ground for erasure under the GDPR applies. Erasure may not be requested where the retention of the data is required by law or for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims.
- **Right to restriction of processing:** The data subject may request the restriction of processing, for example, where they contest the accuracy of the personal data or where the processing is unlawful but the data subject opposes erasure.
- **Right to data portability:** Where processing is based on a contract or consent and carried out by automated means, the data subject may request to receive the personal data concerning them in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and, where technically feasible, request that such data be transmitted to another data controller.
- **Right to object:** The data subject has the right to object to processing based on the legitimate interests of the Data Controller. In the event of an objection, PBT shall no longer process the personal data unless it demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights, and freedoms of the data subject, or where the processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims. Where personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, the personal data shall no longer be processed for such purposes following the objection.

- **Right to withdraw consent:** Where processing is based on consent, the data subject may withdraw their consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to such withdrawal.

7. Handling of Data Subject Requests

7.1. The data subject may submit requests relating to the processing of their personal data by e-mail to **sales@pbtfencing.com** or by post addressed to the registered office of the Data Controller. The Data Controller shall handle such requests in accordance with **Article 12 of the GDPR** and within the time limits set out therein.

8. Remedies

8.1. If the data subject considers that the processing of their personal data infringes the GDPR or any other applicable data protection legislation, they may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

8.3. The data subject is also entitled to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of another Member State of the European Union corresponding to their habitual residence, place of work, or the place of the alleged infringement.

8.4. In the event of unlawful processing of personal data or infringement of the data subject's rights, the data subject may bring legal proceedings before a competent court. At the data subject's choice, proceedings may also be brought before the courts of the Member State in which the Data Controller is established or where the data subject has their habitual residence.

9. Amendments to this Privacy Notice

9.1. The Data Controller reserves the right to amend this Privacy Notice where justified by changes in applicable legislation, regulatory practice, the data processing activities, or the service providers engaged.

9.2. Any amendment shall not result in the retroactive modification of the legal basis for processing already commenced and shall not unjustifiably restrict the rights of data subjects.

9.3. The Data Controller shall make the amended Privacy Notice available in the same location as the Official Rules and, where the amendment is material, shall inform the data subjects in an appropriate manner.
